About the Role

Provide quality research support to enthusiastic team(s) of academics leading research projects. The successful applicant will work in the project called "ChildDataVerif: Verifying the compliance of Android apps against regulations on children's data protection", where they will propose and develop approaches to identify, analyse, and extract the features of Android apps that may have impact on children's personal data.

Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. Propose and develop approaches to identify, analyse, and extract the features of Android apps that may have impact on children's personal data.
- 2. Presentation of results. Contribute to the presentation of results of research to internal groups/PI. Draft reports through appropriate word processing and data presentation software.
- 3. Literature searches. To undertake scoping surveys of bibliographic databases and literature search engines informed by up to date information on related research. Develop an understanding of a range of literature and gaps in literature.
- 4. Project administration. Some administration of projects under the supervision of the line manager, with responsibility for own areas of the project. Seek guidance when appropriate from PI.
- 5. Attending and contributing to research team meetings.

- 6. Being an active member of Department Research Committee and/or working groups associated with particular research projects within the Faculty.
- 7. Initiating and, where appropriate, lead internal networks to facilitate collaborative decision-making
- 8. Adherence to the University's research governance framework
- 9. Contributing to the production of bids for research funding.
- 10. Provision of support for consultancy, research and evaluation activities.
- 11. To make a positive contribution to the work of the Faculty/Department.
